

ELITE SPRING SELECTIONS IV

Ninety two head of Brown Swiss, Guernseys and Milking Shorthorns sold for an overall average of \$2,789 into 18 states from New Hampshire to California.

The 76 Brown Swiss averaged \$2,885. with a top of \$13,300 for a Cadence December 2018 calf from Top Acres Supreme Wizard, the 2017 Madison Grand Champion and 7x All American Nominee. Top Acres, St. Paris, Ohio were the consignors with Dr. Chris Keim and Rosedale Genetics, Fort Atkinson, WI taking her home.

The Guernsey offering averaged \$2,430 on 15 head that included a top seller at \$6,200 on Springhill HP GG Unique-ET, a fancy Tiller fall calf from an E94-6x Jr. All American Nominee. Unique was consigned by Hillpoint Partners & Daniel Baase, Cross Plains, WI and is now the property of Kyle Erickson, Big Prairie, OH.

Seven Milking Shorthorns averaged \$3,014 on a special group—all from “EX” dams. Selling for \$4,800, Elite HP Best Buy ET, was high seller for that group and was consigned by Peter Vail and Hillpoint Partners. Her new owner is Megan Lundy, Jefferson, WI.

The Elite Spring Selections IV Sale was managed by Modern Associates, St. Paris, OH and sponsored by Elite Dairy, Copake, NY.
